Curriculum Information for Autumn Term 2 - 2018-19

Please find below the curriculum outline for this half term.

KS1

English

Topic One: Traditional Tales: Three Little Pigs, Little Red Riding Hood

This will include looking at the features of traditional texts, story language, ordering events, storyboards, character descriptions and re-telling a traditional story.

Big Write: Focusing on using the correct punctuation and writing format.

Topic Two: Recounts: Great Fire of London

This will link to our work on The Great Fire of London and include writing a recount of the event and creating their own experience.

Maths

Topic One: Additive Reasoning

Year 1 Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20

Year 2 Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100

Topic 2: Part, Whole.

Year 1 Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20

Year 2 Recognise and use the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction and use this to check calculations and missing number problems

	<p><u>Topic 3: Equality and Comparison</u></p> <p>Year 1 Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs</p> <p>Year 2 Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = signs</p> <p><u>Topic 4: Measures- Length, Height and Mass</u></p> <p>Year 1 Compare, describe and solve practical problems for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • lengths and heights (for example, long / short, longer / shorter, tall / short, double / half) • mass / weight (for example, heavy / light, heavier than, lighter than) Measure and begin to record the following: • lengths and heights • mass / weight <p>Year 2 Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length / height in any direction (m / cm); mass (kg / g); temperature (°C); capacity (litres / ml) to the nearest appropriate unit, using rulers, scales, thermometers and measuring vessels</p>
Science	<p><u>Materials</u></p> <p>Year 1 and 2 children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses • Find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.
R.E	<p><u>Christmas</u></p> <p>The children will be learning about the Christmas Story and carrying out activities linked to the birth of Jesus. This will also link to the KS1 Christmas production.</p>
History & Art	<p><u>Topic – London Skylines</u></p> <p>The children will be learning about the London Skyline . this will include looking at St. Paul’s Cathedral and making links to The Great Fire of London. The class will also have the opportunity to create their own skyline using a variety of materials and resources.</p>
P.E	<p>The class will have a professional coach to teach rugby for one PE lesson a week.</p> <p>The class will also develop their dance skills this half term. Sessions will include: movement, expression, rhythm and developing routines.</p>
Music	<p>Christmas Production songs- weekly practice of songs used in the KS1 Christmas Productions.</p>
